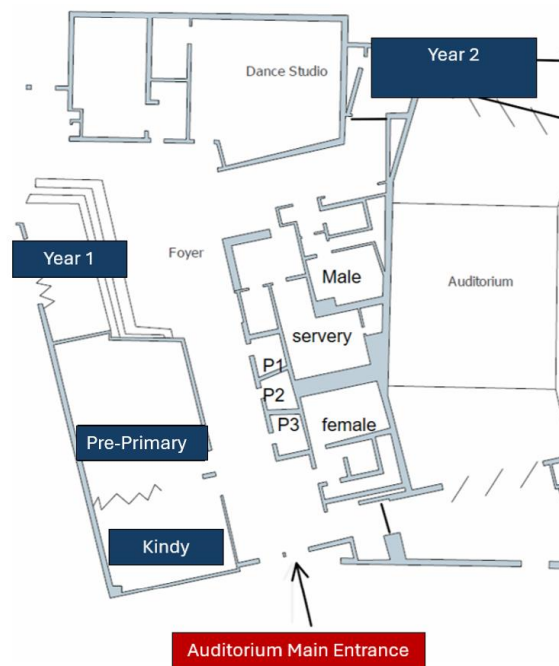
KINDERGARTEN – YEAR 6

General Information

Student Drop Off

Students from Kindergarten to Year 2 should be dropped off from 8:20am at the Marist Auditorium, adjacent to the Lavalla Campus on the [Marcellin Campus](#), via Entry 3, 4 or 5. The drop off locations are shown below. Please note the Mass will commence at 9:00am.



- **Kindy:** students are to be taken to Auditorium Studio 1
- **Pre-Primary:** students are to be taken to Auditorium Studio 2
- **Year 1:** students are to be taken to the Auditorium Foyer
- **Year 2:** students are to be taken to the side foyer of the Auditorium
- **Years 3-6:** students will arrive as usual at the Lavalla Campus and go to their normal classrooms.

Students should remember to bring a hat, drink bottle, and morning tea in their regular school bag.

Uniform Requirements

Students in Kindergarten to Year 6 are asked to wear their Sports Uniform with the Blue Newman College Polo.

Lunches

The canteen will be operating as normal this day. Orders can be placed via Flexischools. Students are welcome to bring a packed lunch also.

Primary Lapathon

At the conclusion of lunch, primary students will join their buddy class to take part in the Lapathon on the Lavalla Oval.
