NAPLAN (National Literacy and Numeracy Assessment) is undertaken each year by students in Years 3, 5, 7, and 9. NAPLAN will take place in Week 6 and 7 of Term 1. Please see the schedule below:

We would like to remind you that your child is not required to prepare for the assessment but is encouraged to do their best. Teachers will ensure that students are familiar with the types of questions in the test and will provide the appropriate support and guidance.

### Specific Requirements

#### Year 3

Students will use school-based iPads for their assessments, apart from Writing which will be handwritten. **Students are required to bring their own headphones.**

#### Year 5

Students will use school-based iPads for their assessments. **Students are required to bring their own headphones.**

#### Years 7 & 9

Students must have their own laptops, fully charged with the NAP browser installed and working, **and a pair of headphones.** Students should have downloaded this at school with the support of their teacher. Those who have been absent and have not installed this browser will need to do so via this link <https://support.newman.wa.edu.au/naplan-2/>

### Catchup Assessments

If your child is absent on the day of the scheduled assessment, every effort will be made to give students the opportunity to complete the assessment upon their return to school in line with the NAPLAN rules for missed assessments.
